The Kadiwéu are an indigenous people currently living between the Paraguay River and the Bodoquena Mountains in Mato Grosso do Sul , Brazil. Viviane Luiza Silva's talk will analyze Kadiwéu pottery production in relation to the cultural, environmental, political, and economic contexts of Kadiwéu women's labor.
