PUYR, AN INDIGENOUS LEADER OF THE TEMBÉ PEOPLE FROM ALTO RIO GUAMA IN THE BRAZILIAN AMAZON, IS THE FIRST SECRETARIAT OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES OF PARÁ AND CO-FOUNDER OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF INDIGENOUS ANCESTRAL WOMEN WARRIORS (ANMIGA).
