FOR RESEARCH

The J. Keith Behner and Catherine M. Stiefel Program on Brazil provides seed money to faculty doing research in or on Brazil. This funding is intended to support preliminary research to improve competitiveness for external funding. For the 2019 competition, faculty can propose to conduct field research or to bring research collaborators to the SDSU campus.

FOR TEACHING

Faculty seeking to strengthen teaching on Brazil in their classes are eligible for funding. The Program on Brazil can sponsor course development, guest lectures, small workshops, or other activities that support undergraduate or graduate classes. Programming requests are accepted on a rolling basis. Requests for course development should be submitted by the March deadline. Integration of Brazil-specific content into existing courses is permitted and encouraged.
